Credit for Proficiency

Work is completed satisfactorily for an Algebra I or geometry course in a district feeder school or by home-school students provided the student and feeder school/home-school instructor comply with the following criteria:

1. The feeder school must contact the district superintendent and request a teacher of record at the beginning of the course.
2. The teacher of record shall be a highly qualified teacher certified to teach high school level mathematics.
3. The student shall maintain a complete organized portfolio throughout the course to include select assignments, tests, and any extra work. This portfolio should be submitted for review to the teacher of record in the district by the first of May.
4. The student shall take a proficiency exam achieving a minimum score required by district to prove proficiency. This proficiency exam will be administered by the district in May of each year it is necessary.
5. The feeder school district will be responsible for compensating the district of record at their current hourly rate for facilitating the curriculum throughout the course and reviewing the student's portfolio. This time investment should not exceed 5 hours per course.
6. Credit shall only be given to students meeting the above detailed criteria for the courses of Algebra I and geometry. Credits in more advanced math must be taken at the district high school.
