Evaluation of Instructional Programs

As a review of each teachers' individual program, the faculty will meet on one of the in-service days at the end of each school year. At this meeting, the designated counselor will present the results of any applicable tests, including, but not limited to the following: PSAT, SAT, ACT and State-Wide Assessment Tests. From this information, the teachers will be able to find what areas of their program might be deficient and make corrections. Test results and what we are doing to make corrections will be reported to the Board during an open meeting.

The site councils will distribute surveys as needed, pertaining to instructional programs and school climate to teachers, parents and students. The survey results will be reported to the community in the site council newsletter *CUHS Insights*.

The school counselor will develop an alumni survey in order to assess how our instructional programs have met the needs of recent graduates.

Staff development training in assessment will take place periodically. Some teachers are experimenting with portfolio development. (Business Department and Computer Science 1994-95 and 1995-96.)
