

Student Absences and Excuses

1. The only excused absence is illness and/or medical and school activities.
2. All other absences are not excused, i.e., hair appointments, absence because student could not get ride to school, car trouble, vacations and shopping.
3. Students who have been absent need to bring a written note from home or parents must telephone the office.
4. Any student who exceeds five days unexcused absences per quarter in any class will not receive credit for that class (Oregon Revised Statute 339.065).
5. Appeals for exceptional circumstances may be made to the superintendent.
6. All class work must be made up regardless of being excused or unexcused.
 - a. Make-up work is the teacher's responsibility. Teachers may require student's presence before and/or after school.
 - b. No make-up work will be turned in after the last day of the quarter.
7. There is no penalty for unexcused absences until the number exceeds five.
