## **Motorized and Nonmotorized Vehicles and Student Bicycle Use**

Bicycle riders are encouraged to observe safe and lawful practices. All bicycle riders under the age of 16 must comply with Oregon helmet laws.

All drivers must be licensed to drive on public roads.

The district will report all unlicensed drivers to the authorities. The district encourages unlicensed students to obtain a special permit to drive to and from school.

The following regulations are necessary because of parking, traffic patterns and the desire of many parents to have the school know the whereabouts of their students.

Any licensed driver may drive a licensed vehicle onto the school premises under the following conditions:

1. No student vehicle will be permitted to leave the school grounds during school hours without the permission of the school administration and the student's parent(s);
2. Students are not permitted in cars parked on school grounds at anytime, except with special permission of the administration;
3. Students who live in the dormitory will not be allowed to move their vehicles during the week or weekend during school activities, etc., without the direct permission of the parents and/or administration;
4. Cars, motor bikes, bikes, etc., must be parked in the assigned places or area and locked at all times while on the school premises;
5. Students in mechanics class may, with teacher permission, move their vehicle to the school working area for educational training and repairs under the instructor's supervision.

The law states that all drivers must be licensed to drive on public roads.

Because of the liability to those who observe unlicensed drivers driving, the district is to notify unlicensed students who drive to school (even though you park off campus) that you will be reported to the authorities.

It is possible to obtain a special permit to drive to and from school. We encourage those of you who must drive to obtain the permit.
