Advisors to the Board

The ESD may appoint, as nonvoting advisory members to the Board, a person to represent employment training agencies and a person to represent social service agencies in the district.

The advisory members shall be appointed for two-year terms and may be reappointed. Notwithstanding the two-year term of office, one of the two advisory members initially chosen shall serve for two years and one shall serve for three years as determined by lot.

A representative of an employment training agency is a person from the area who is knowledgeable about employment training issues and is a board or staff member affiliated with one of the following:

1. Regional workforce quality committee;
2. Community college;
3. Vocational rehabilitation agency;
4. Employment department or employment office;
5. Job Training Partnership Act program;
6. JOBS program;
7. Job Service Employer Committee; or
8. Other public or private organization with an employment training purpose.

A representative of a social service agency is a person from the area who is knowledgeable about service issues and is a Board or staff member affiliated with one of the following:

1. County Commission on Children and Families;
2. County health department;
3. Adult and family service agency;
4. Children's service agency;
5. Head Start or Oregon Pre-Kindergarten Program;

6. Family resource center;
7. Juvenile justice department;
8. Teen parent program;
9. Minority health program;
10. Legal aid;
11. Women's Infant and Children program; or
12. Other public or private organization with a social service purpose.

Advisory members shall be appointed to promote interorganizational cooperation and coordination in the region and shall not serve as representatives of any specific organization.

Advisory members shall:

1. Assist the district Board in analyzing the issues, proposals and requests before them;
2. Receive the information sent to the members of the Board;
3. Participate in regular Board and budget committee meetings but shall not participate in executive sessions of the Board except by invitation of the Board; and
4. Meet criteria of performance established by the Board.
