## Safety Program

1. The ESD Board shall operate a central office and such other physical facilities as needed to meet district goals and statutory requirements.
2. The ESD shall maintain inspection reports showing the district in compliance with health and safety regulations.
3. The ESD shall conduct and document regularly scheduled safety inspections of all facilities and properties under its direct jurisdiction, including required fire drills if children use these facilities.
4. The ESD shall post an emergency medical plan for obtaining first aid, ambulance, hospital and physician services.
5. First-aid supplies and qualified first-aid personnel shall be available at ESD facilities.
