## Student Policy Objectives

Any student enrolled in an ESD program by a component school district is a resident of that component school district and is the legal responsibility of such district.

One of the educational program's main tasks shall be to assist each student in becoming self-sufficient and responsible in problem solving and decision making.

Each student shall be considered an individual.

Staff members shall guide and counsel students in the learning process. The Board and staff shall work together to provide an environment appropriate for student learning by meeting the following goals:

1. Individualize the instructional program with an emphasis on the basic skills;
2. Protect and observe the legal rights of students;
3. Build each student's self-image through positive reinforcement and success-orientated activities;
4. Provide an environment of responsibility in which students can learn personal and civic duties;
5. Deal with students fairly and consistently in discipline matters;
6. Provide for the student's safety, health and welfare;
7. Promote faithful attendance and quality work;
8. Support students' academic growth beyond proficiency in academic content standards; and
9. Encourage their attainment of individual goals.

Through this environment the ESD will prepare students to function in a rapidly changing world.

The ESD shall keep the component school district apprised of the student's progress and maintain necessary records.

The ESD shall forward attendance records needed by the component school district to claim State School Fund moneys for students enrolled in ESD-operated classrooms.
