Admission of Nonresident Students

It is the policy of Helix School District #1-R to allow out of district students to attend Helix Schools under the following conditions:

1. An agreement must be reached between the student's home district and Helix Schools to allow Helix School District to collect Basic School Support Funds. By written consent of the affected school boards the student becomes a "resident student" of the attending school district.
2. By June 1st of each year, the superintendent/principal will establish an approximate number of non-resident students the classes can accommodate for the following year. Class size will be held to approximately (20) students in the high school and middle school grades with a limit of approximately (15) in the primary grades.
3. The petition for admission must be in writing and go through the superintendent's office.
4. Students will be allowed to enroll at Helix Schools at the semester. Student's educational records will be obtained at the time of petition for the student study team review each year.
5. Out of district students will be allowed to attend Helix School under the following conditions:
 - a. Helix School District will be entitled to all state monies.
 - b. Student Study Team review of student's records.
 - c. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent or guardian.
 - d. Students must be in good standing in the district from which they are transferring.
 - e. Out of district students who become involved in major discipline problems, including, but not limited to fights, assault, drugs, alcohol, property damage or threats will be asked to return to their home district immediately.
 - f. The parent/guardian and student must sign an agreement indicating they will comply with these conditions.
6. All students will be subject to Staff, Board and Superintendent/Principal's annual review.
