District Curriculum

To achieve excellence in the area of student achievement, the district is committed to having an aligned state, district and classroom curriculum. The curriculum derives from Oregon's academic content standards and the instructional framework established by the standards. District teachers will teach the instructional framework and assess student proficiency on standards.

To meet the curriculum goals of the district, all curriculum will be consistent with the district's stated mission and goals and with the desires of the residents of the district. All state laws and State Board of Education rules will be followed.

The Board recognizes that to provide quality instructional programs and to respond to changing needs, it cannot permit the district curriculum to remain static. The Board deems it essential that the district develop and implement an instructional management system which will modify curricula to meet changing needs.

While instructional differentiation is expected to occur to address the unique needs of all students, instruction shall be derived from the standard instructional framework common to all students.

All curriculum decisions, including elimination or addition of programs, courses and extensive content alteration, will be subject to Board approval.

The superintendent will establish administrative regulations implementing this policy. These will be consistent with guidelines as provided by the Oregon Department of Education.
