Traffic Safety Education

The following procedures shall be used in implementing the district's Driver Education Program.

Tuition Rate

Each year, prior to the Board's July organization meeting, the superintendent will provide the Board with data regarding the district's Driver Education Program. The data shall include expected enrollment, the cost of the program, the amount of state reimbursement, and other information appropriate for determining the tuition rate. The tuition rate will be adopted at the regular July Board meeting.

Non-resident Students

Non-resident students will be allowed to participate in the district Driver Education Program after resident student enrollment is established and it has been determined there is adequate room and resources available.

All students shall be subject to the district code of conduct, policies and regulations. Violation may result in disciplinary action up to and including denial to participate in the Driver Education Program.

Financial Hardship

Families who believe the tuition fee is a severe hardship, may set up a "payment plan" with the high school principal and bookkeeper. Each situation will be analyzed on its own merit by the building principal who will then make the decision on whether a student qualifies due to hardship.
