Cocurricular/Extracurricular Activities

The Board will maintain a student activity program appropriate to the maturity of students and as varied as funding, staff and facilities permit. The program will be designed to offer to as many students as possible worthwhile athletic and leisure-time interests, wholesome recreational and social activities and opportunities to develop skills in cooperation.

Supervision

Whenever or wherever held, when conducted under the name of the school or district or any class or organization thereof, cocurricular/extracurricular activities will be under the general supervision of school personnel.

Each activity will have a licensed staff member who will be responsible for the overall program and the supervision of the individual participants.

Each building administrator or his/her designee will coordinate the scheduling of all activities and all competition will be with his/her approval. Decisions on building assigned funds rest with the building administrator.
