Reporting to Parents**

The district subscribes to a combination of formal record cards and to the use of individual parent conferences as the best methods of reporting the student's progress.

The following standard means of reporting to parents shall be used:

1. Report cards developed by the administration with appropriate input from staff, parents and students and designed in keeping with the philosophy of the district;
2. Parent teacher conferences designed to compliment written reports of student progress and scheduled by the district administration;
3. Mid-term reports of failing and/or below level work on a teacher-to-parent basis either by way of progress reports or by direct communications.

In addition to the above, the staff of the various buildings are encouraged to:

1. Make home visits where there appears to be a special need in terms of home-school communication and/or cooperation;
2. Send home various kinds of positive reports on students who have made special efforts and achievements especially in areas that are not easily reported through the more formal means;
3. Commend students for particular academic, activity and citizenship achievements through publications and special recognition devices.

In an effort to promote effective communication with individuals with disabilities, the school will provide progress reports in an alternative format upon request and with appropriate advance notice.

Full consideration will be given to the requests of the person with a disability in the selection of appropriate auxiliary aids and services.
