Homeless Students

Homeless students will not be stigmatized nor segregated because of their status as homeless. A homeless student will be admitted to the district school in the attendance area in which the student is actually living or to the student's school of origin as requested by the parent and in accordance with the student's best interest. Transportation will be provided to and from the student's school of origin at the request of the parent, or in the case of an unaccompanied student, the district's liaison for homeless students.

A liaison for students in homeless situations will be designated by the district to carry out duties as required by law.

The superintendent will develop administrative regulations to implement this policy.
