Superintendent

The Board authorizes and delegates the authority to the superintendent to act within the law, policies, procedures and philosophy approved by the Board.

The superintendent is the district's chief executive officer and has, under the Board's direction, general supervision of all district goals, personnel and departments. The superintendent is responsible for managing the schools under the Board's policies and is accountable to the Board for that management.

The superintendent may delegate to other school personnel any powers and duties imposed upon the superintendent by Board policies or by vote of the Board. Delegation of power or duty, however, will not relieve the superintendent of responsibility for action taken under such delegation.

The superintendent or designee is authorized to represent the district in planning and negotiating with such agencies and individuals as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the district.

The superintendent and business manager shall be responsible for negotiating, administering and signing contracts for goods and services for the district.
