2. Developing building renovations which meet state and federal requirements on the accessibility and useability of facilities to persons with disabilities.
3. Creating building designs, construction, and renovations that will allow low maintenance costs, safe work environments, and the conservation of energy.
4. Meeting all safety requirements through the remodeling of older structures.
