## Fund-Raising Activities

To provide additional opportunities for student activities, sports and events beyond those provided with public funding, students and parent groups may engage in fund raising. Fund raising that involves students must be planned to assure student safety and good community support. The district desires equity of opportunity for all students; fund raising must not unduly unbalance equity between schools.

1. All fund raising that uses the school's name or the name of an activity (such as a team or a club) must be pre-approved by the principal, including fundraising by parent groups such as PTOs. Fund raising initiated by students for an outside organization or charity must also be pre-approved by the principal. Fund raising for organizations outside the school initiated by adults outside the school using students to raise funds is generally discouraged.
2. Each principal will maintain a log of all approved fund raising activities to be submitted upon request to the Board, showing the method for the fund raising, whether students were involved directly in raising the funds, the use of the funds, and the amount raised by the activity.
3. Principals will limit the number of times each year that students directly sell items to the community and the incentives offered for student selling.

If fund raising consists of selling food and beverage items to students during the regular or extended school day, the food and beverage items must comply with state and federal nutrition standards, rules and laws. This does not apply to food and beverage items sold at school-related or nonschool-related events for which parents and other adults are a significant part of the audience.

4. Funds raised by student groups must be managed as student body funds by the school. All cash must be secured in the building following building procedure and deposited promptly. See Board policy DM - Cash in District Buildings.
