**Student Progress Reports to Parents\*\***

Each school will develop methods to report to parents/guardian regarding student progress in school. The Board will from time to time, evaluate the effectiveness of the plan in reporting to parents.

Each school's plan will include:

1. Assessing and recording each student's progress in all subject areas of instruction;
2. Records of student performance may be kept in teacher grade books, portfolios, student folders or similar devices;
3. Annual report of progress toward completion of graduation requirements to parents of students in grades 9-12;
4. Annual reports to parents on progress in each subject area, including goals used to determine such information, and the statewide achievement test scores;
5. Maintaining progress records under student's legal name;
6. Teacher documentation of how grade given was determined.

In an effort to promote effective communications with individuals with disabilities, the school will provide progress reports in an alternative format upon request and with appropriate advance notice.

Full consideration will be given to the requests of the person with a disability in the selection of appropriate auxiliary aids and services.
