## High School Credit for Middle School Students

The Board encourages students to perform at the highest level possible in their course work. Recognizing that some middle school-aged students are able to master existing high school curriculum it is the policy of the district to allow middle school students, who are qualified, to take designated high school courses and to apply the credit earned during middle school to their high school transcripts.

After consultation with content area teachers, the Superintendent, or designee, will identify courses in which middle school students will have the option of receiving high school credit. Middle school students choosing to accept high school course credit will receive the grade earned in the class on their high school transcript.

Students will still be required to earn the requisite number of credits in each subject area during their high school years (9-12) as required by the Board in Policy IKF to earn a diploma in the Hood River County School District.

The Superintendent will establish procedures consistent with this policy.
