Student Dress and Grooming**

The responsibility for the dress and grooming of a student rests primarily with the student and parents or guardians. Ordinarily, students' dress or grooming shall not affect their participation in school classes or programs or in school-related activities. If, however, the dress or grooming of a student disrupts the educational climate or process, or is unclean, or a threat to the health and safety of the student, or any other person, the school has a legitimate concern and may require the student to change the mode of dress or grooming.

Students who represent the school in a voluntary activity may be required to conform to dress and grooming standards approved by the superintendent and may be denied the opportunity to participate if those standards are not met.
