## **Crisis Prevention and Response**

The Board recognizes that schools are subject to a number of potentially violent events. No school is immune from these events no matter the size or location.

The Board is committed to the prevention of violence against people or property in the schools or at school activities, whether by students, staff or others. While committed to each person's constitutional rights, including due process rights, the Board does not condone lawlessness. The Board knows that schools cannot be sanctuaries but protecting students in an increasingly violent world is a challenge that must be accepted.

The superintendent shall direct the administration to develop a Crisis Prevention and Response Plan. The administration will develop said plan in conjunction with its community partners, which may include law enforcement agencies, mental health providers, emergency responders and any other agencies are partners as necessary.

The superintendent shall direct the administration to regularly review the plan, protocols, procedures and safety needs.

The superintendent may develop an administrative regulation that ensures the effective development and implementation of the district's plan.
