Community Education

The community education concept stresses an expanded role for public education and provides a dynamic approach to individual and community improvement. Community education encourages development of a comprehensive and coordinated delivery system for providing educational, recreational, social and cultural services for all people in the community. The Board accepts the concept of community education, recognizing the expanded role of the school system as a comprehensive community opportunity center for all ages.

The Board recognizes that good schools involve the active participation and cooperation of the entire community. School buildings, equipment and staff represent a considerable investment of public funds and it is desirable that these resources be used fully.

Board policy supports the community education concept and provides for a cooperative effort with other community organizations in school facility and grounds use to include community education activities that provide a wide range of educational, social, recreational and cultural programs for district citizens.
