Extended Instructional Programs

Definition

Off-campus experiences shall be defined as learning experiences in which the majority of learning is supervised by other than district employees in a setting removed from regular school buildings and grounds. The experiences shall be integrally related to the school curriculum, and should be described in a specific written agreement among parent, school, student, and if deemed necessary, the outside agency.

Rationale

The community should be recognized as an extension of the classroom. Involvement in the on-going activities of diverse business enterprises, community agencies, and other governmental and private organizations can provide valuable educational experiences for study. Schools should increasingly utilize resources in designing educational programs appropriate to diverse student needs, interests and abilities.
