Field Trips and Special Events Staff and Volunteer Code of Ethics

The district recognizes the value of special activities in the total curriculum and agrees that students profit from carefully planned learning experiences. In planning these activities adequate supervision must be arranged. District staff and volunteer staff must abide by the Standard of Performance for Oregon Educators. In addition to these expectations, volunteers are required to complete the following Code of Ethics for volunteers as well as complete an Oregon Department of Education Criminal History Verification of Applicants:

As a volunteer, I realize I am subject to a code of ethics, similar to that which binds professional educators, I too, expect to be accountable for ethical responsibilities. They include the following:

1. To keep confidential all matters pertaining to students, their records, including grades and test scores, and their parents;
2. To be dependable and committed to my work;
3. To serve without monetary compensation but work with the same high standard as employed staff;
4. To have a professional attitude toward volunteer work;
5. To have an obligation to my work, to those who direct it, to my coworkers, to the children, to the school and to the community;
6. To do my best to improve communications between students and faculty, and between the district and community;
7. To use good taste in grooming and dress in order to set an example for the students.
