Disposal of District Property

The superintendent or principal, or designee, may dispose of all obsolete, surplus, unwanted and/or excessively damaged equipment and supplies owned by the district in accordance with the following procedures:

1. The Board will pass a resolution declaring the property surplus;
2. Items estimated by the district to have a value of less than \$100 may be sold by administration at prices estimated to be the market values or given to the Ione Education Foundation;
3. All sales will be recorded by item, price and buyer;
4. Property or materials estimated by the district clerk to be greater than \$100 may be declared surplus by the Board and submitted to the Ione Education Foundation and sold by the Foundation through a bidding procedure or by public auction. If public sales fail to produce any interested buyers or bidders, remaining unsold materials may then, at the superintendent/principal's discretion, be disposed of as scrap or waste or be donated to appropriate charitable or educational agencies.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.
