## High School Classes/Courses for Eighth Graders

The District encourages students to perform at the highest level possible in their course work.

Recognizing that some middle school age students are able to master existing high school curriculum, it is the policy of the District to allow eighth grade students, who are qualified, to take designated high school classes/courses. High school credit may be granted, if students taking high school courses are required to meet performance criteria that are equivalent to the performance criteria for students taking the same high school classes.

At the completion of the high school course, students will need to determine if they wish to receive high school credit. If a student wishes to receive credit for a high school course taken while in middle school, his/her request will be granted and the grade/credit will be put on their freshman transcript and figure into their GPA from that point on. Once a class is posted to the transcript, it cannot be removed at the student's or parent's request.

A student may request to retake a high school course taken in middle school if they wish to improve their grade and receive high school credit during their freshman year.

The District will not allow the granting of such credit to be used to reduce below (26) twenty-six the units of credit to be completed in grades 9 through 12 for high school graduation.
