

Admission of Nonresident Students

Guidelines for Nonresident Students Cap

1. Maximum resident and nonresident student population will be 235.
 - a. 90 students at high school (grades 9-12);
 - b. 55 students at middle school (grades 6-8);
 - c. 90 students at elementary school (grades K-5).
2. Currently enrolled out-of-district students maintain enrollment through graduation.
3. Siblings of currently enrolled out-of-district students may enroll.

Procedure for Enrollment of Out-of-District Students

1. Students will provide the following information:
 - a. Name;
 - b. Contact Information;
 - c. Date of Birth;
 - d. Grade;
 - e. Whether student is currently expelled from current district.
2. Nonresident students will be selected in the order their enrollment request was received and within the above school limits.
3. Upon meeting the enrollment cap listed above, nonresident students requesting to enroll will be placed on a waiting list. Students on the waiting list will be selected in the order their requests were received and within the above school limits.
4. At the beginning of each semester (August and January), the Ione principal will determine the number of available openings at each of the schools.
5. In the order described in section 2. above, the principal will contact the student's family to determine if they are still interested in enrolling.
6. The principal will work down the wait list until the cap has been met or the list has been exhausted.
7. Students will remain on the wait list until they have the option to enroll, choose not to enroll or reach the age of graduation.
