First Aid**

The district nurse shall perform first aid and emergency care, as appropriate. In the event that the school nurse is not available, first aid may be administered by the principal or other administrator, a counselor, a teacher or another staff member.

Staff members shall report self-administered first aid treatment to an immediate supervisor.

In each school, procedures for handling health emergencies will be established and made known to the staff. Each school and school vehicle will be equipped with appropriate first-aid supplies and equipment. All employees are expected to know where first-aid supplies and equipment are kept in their work areas.

Designated employees in each building shall hold current first-aid cards. In compliance with Oregon Administrative Rules, each school shall have, at a minimum, at least one staff member with a current first aid card for every 60 students enrolled or an emergency response team per building. Such teams shall consist of no less than six persons who hold current first aid/CPR cards and who are trained annually in the district and building emergency plans. Names of the designated employees will be posted.
