

Video Cameras on Transportation Vehicles

The Board, as a part of the district's ongoing program to improve student discipline and ensure the health, welfare and safety of all those riding school transportation vehicles, shall utilize video cameras on any school vehicles transporting students to and from curricular and extracurricular activities.

The superintendent is directed to develop administrative regulations for the notification of staff, students, parents and others as necessary of the use of video cameras on school transportation vehicles and other such procedures as may be required for the implementation of this policy.
