Interdistrict Transfer of Resident Students**

A hardship transfer request out of Jackson County School District 9 may be permitted if there is no other district school to which the student may transfer and, at the reasonable discretion of the district, to protect the health safety or welfare in the best interest of the student.

When the district approves the release of a resident student under the above criteria, the resident student's family will be solely responsible for transportation.

The district may not impose any limitations on the length of time for which consent is given to any student requesting release to another district.

The district shall allow a student whose legal residence changes to a different district during the school year, to complete the school year in the district if the student/parent chooses to do so.

The superintendent is directed to establish procedures for the review of student requests to attend school in another district. The district will comply with all state and federal laws.
