

Student Dress and Grooming**

Dress and grooming while in school is primarily an individual responsibility of student and parent. When dress and grooming disrupt the learning process, it becomes a matter for discussion with the student and/or parent.

Student dress and grooming is the responsibility of the student and parent and comes into school control under the following conditions:

1. Dress and grooming shall be clean and consistent with health, sanitary and safety practices;
2. Dress and grooming shall not disrupt the teaching-learning process;
3. When a student is participating in special activities, dress and grooming shall not disrupt the performance or constitute a health or safety hazard to the individual or to others;
4. Provisions for dress and grooming in special activities should be appropriate to the needs of the activities.
