Selection and Use of Instructional Materials

The Board intends that a wide range of instructional materials be available to teachers and to students. The selection of these materials will be proposed by the district administrator and approved by the Board. The procedure will include a way to receive and respond to a formal request for review of the materials that are provided to students.

1. The district administrator will provide a process through which the staff may be involved in the selection of instructional materials used in the district programs.
2. The selection of district textbooks will be carried out as needed to use the state-adopted textbooks.
3. A wide range of library and other resource materials for use in the district classrooms, including films, will be selected in keeping with the district program and the needs of the community.
4. A process for accepting a challenge to any item used in the instructional program will be developed, approved by the Board, made known to the public and followed.
