Communicable Diseases

The district is committed to provide a healthy environment for all staff and students. The district shall follow the regulations and guidelines set forth by the Oregon State Health Division, the Marion County Health Department and advisors in the district, to prevent the spread of disease in the school and/or work setting. The superintendent shall develop procedures and guidelines to implement this policy.

“School-Restrictable” Communicable/Infectious Diseases

School-restrictable diseases are those diseases which have a high risk of transmission to others and which, under OAR 333-19-015, require that students be excluded from the school environment until they are no longer afflicted with the condition in a communicable stage.

“Non-School-Restrictable” Communicable/Infectious Diseases

Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome (AIDS), AIDS Related Complex (ARC), HIV and blood-borne hepatitis viral infection are non “school-restrictable” diseases under OAR 333-19-015 or local health department designation.
