

Student School Board Representatives

The following rules will apply to student representatives to the Board.

Selection Process

1. The Board shall have student representatives as advisory members.
2. The Board Representatives will serve up to two years. If they are unable to complete the two years another student will be selected.
3. The principal will consider recommendations from the high school student council in selecting the student representative.
4. The term of office is for up to two school years and shall be effective from July 1 through June 30.
5. If a representative resigns for any reason, the principal may be asked to select a replacement to complete the representative's term.

Responsibilities

1. Representatives will sit with the Board and be included in all deliberations except those taking place in executive session.
2. Representatives will give opinions and provide input as any regularly elected member of the Board but will not have voting privileges.
3. Student representatives shall be installed as advisors through the following oath of office:

"I (the student will state their name) will support the Constitution and laws of the United States of America and the state of Oregon and will discharge the duties of Student Representative to the Jefferson County School District 509J Board to the best of my ability."
4. Representatives or their families will be responsible for transportation to and from meetings. Transportation costs may be reimbursed as per district policy and by Board approval.
5. Student representatives are responsible for maintaining their eligibility as required for any other extracurricular activity or office as determined by the principal.
6. Student representatives will receive Board information packets except confidential materials relating to personnel, collective bargaining or legal issues.
7. The Board reserves the right to end the student representative program in the event the members determine it is no longer beneficial to the district.
