## Scholarship Award

Students may receive an Academic Scholarship Award when they meet or exceed the state assessment standards for grade 10, have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 and completed requirements for a district diploma, including a community service project. (See Board policy IKF - Graduation Requirements and IKF-AR - Graduation Requirement: Representative Body of Evidence.) The student is required to be enrolled at Jewell for a minimum of three high school years with an average attendance of 90 percent excluding absences for school approved activities. By recommendation of three teachers, the superintendent and approval of the Board, any student less than 21 years of age who has met the above requirements may be considered.

In recognition of this academic achievement, the district may be awarded up to \$1,000 scholarship per year for up to two years to these students. This money may be applied towards tuition and fees at any accredited institution of post secondary learning (i.e., university, community college, technical or trade school) and will be paid directly to the school.

Payment for each year will be made upon receipt of proof of registration.

To be eligible for this award (up to \$1,000 per year for up to two years for tuition and fees at any accredited institution of post secondary learning), the individual must have achieved the 10th grade state assessment standards. ( Call the school counsel to schedule retests of these subjects, if necessary). Should costs be incurred in retesting students, the district will cover the costs of the first two retests per individual. Any further costs of retesting will be the responsibility of the individual.
