## Resuscitation

The district staff will dial 911 whenever resuscitation is needed.

The district staff shall use resuscitation techniques with the objective of restoring life. Such efforts shall continue until trained, medical assistance arrives.

The district defines resuscitation as an attempt to restore breathing and/or a pulse.

After calling 911, the district shall immediately contact the parent/guardian. The staff will undertake live-saving measures they are trained to provide while awaiting the arrival of emergency medical services.

If the parent/guardian arrives at school before or during the time that EMTs are on the scene, parent/guardian may take whatever action they choose, including removing their child from the school.
