The superintendent or his/her designee will develop and maintain a recruitment program designed to attract classified personnel to the district.

It is the responsibility of the superintendent, with the assistance of other district administrators, to determine the district's personnel needs and to locate most suitably qualified candidates to recommend for district employment.

The search for classified staff members may extend to a wide variety of educational institutions and geographical areas. It will consider the district's diverse characteristics and the requirements of the district affirmative action plan and programs.

Present employees are encouraged to apply for any position.
