

Admission of Part-Time Private School Students

1. Admission of part-time private school students will be restricted to educational or extracurricular programs not offered at the private school.
2. Principals will establish the maximum number of private school students that their respective programs can accommodate based on available space.
3. Admission applications must go through the principal's office to the superintendent's office.
4. Student education records will be obtained and reviewed prior to admission. Proficiency placement exams or auditions may be required prior to admission.
5. Initial admittance and annual renewal must be approved by the superintendent or designee.
6. In-district, full-time and part-time students will be given preference over private school students.
7. Only private school students who live within district boundaries will be considered for class enrollment.
8. Students who request to participate in extracurricular activities in grades 9-12 must meet eligibility requirements not only of the district but also for programs administered by the Oregon School Activities Association. In addition to the regular participation fee established by the district, private school students will be required to pay an additional \$50 per extracurricular activity to cover expenses incurred as a result of their participation.
9. Private school students will be required to provide any transportation that is not normally provided by the district, including but not limited to transportation to and from practice sites.
