Admission of Nonresident Students

The district reserves the right to accept/reject non-resident students based upon the availability of space, resources, personnel, appropriate programs and a positive review of both educational and behavioral records. The Board shall deny regular school admission to a non-resident student who has been expelled from another district.

The Board may consider situations such as:

1. Children with unusual academic needs or abilities that can be met more readily by school services available in a non-resident district;
2. Children living in remote areas whose school transportation can be met more conveniently and efficiently by the non-resident district; and
3. Children with unusual disciplinary or emotional programs who would have a greater ability to succeed in the environment of the non-resident district.

The Board shall deny regular school admission to non-resident students who are under expulsion from another district for a weapons policy violation. The Board will deny admission to non-resident students who are under expulsion from another district for reasons other than a weapons policy violation.

The district may enroll non-resident students as follows:

1. By written consent of the affected districts. The student becomes a “resident pupil” of the attending district thereby allowing the attending district to receive Basic School Support Fund moneys;
2. By unilaterally admitting with tuition a non-resident student whereby neither district is eligible for Basic School Support Fund monies.
