Intradistrict Transfer Students

The superintendent or his/her designee will establish guidelines which may grant permission for a student to attend another school in the district, provided both schools agree to the request.

Students who attend a district school identified for improvement, corrective action or restructuring under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 may, as required by law, transfer to another public school in the district which has not been identified for improvement or as persistently dangerous. Additionally, students who attend a district school identified as persistently dangerous, or who are victims of a violent criminal offense occurring in or on the grounds of the school the student attends, may transfer to a safe public school in the district that has not been identified as in need of improvement.
