

Student Demonstrations and Petitions

It is important to the orderly use of school facilities that the use of all space be carefully planned.

Students, faculty and administration all must share responsibility in activities conducted in school. Indeed, these groups are accountable to the public, to the Board and to the legislature. Each group is accountable for the proper image of the institution and accountable to each other.

Right

Students are permitted to hold meetings on school property under the following conditions:

Responsibility

1. They shall allow orderly and normal operation of the educational process to continue;
2. They shall observe the rights of others to pursue their activities;
3. Meetings in classrooms shall be scheduled in advance with prior principal approval;
4. They shall allow normal class activities to continue;
5. They shall not create a hazard to person or property;
6. They shall be sponsored by school officials or an official school club organization;
7. The meetings shall be preceded, if a crowd is anticipated, by filing of a crowd control plan in the principal's office well in advance of the meeting.
