Grading System

The district's reporting system shall be based on Board adopted course content and is designed to enable the student and parent to clearly know how well the student is achieving course requirements at the student's current grade level, and be based on the student's progress toward mastery in a continuum of knowledge and skills.

Letter grades will be used in the district.

Grading progress reports will be issued on a six week basis. The six week grade progress report will be based on many factors such as: attendance; basic instructional assignments, both oral and written; class participation; special assignments; research; activities of various types and kinds; and special contributions.

Absenteeism or misconduct shall not be the sole criterion for the reduction of a student's grades.

At the beginning of the grading period students and parents will be informed regarding the basis of the grades and the methods to be used in determining them.
