**High School Classes/Courses for Middle School Students**

The district encourages students to perform at the highest level possible in their course work. Recognizing that some upper level elementary school age students are able to master existing high school curriculum, it is the policy of the district to allow seventh and eighth grade students, who are qualified, to take designated high school classes/courses. High school credit may be granted, if students taking pregrade nine courses are required to meet performance criteria that are equivalent to the performance criteria for students taking the same high school classes.

The district will allow the granting of such credit to be used toward the 24 units of credit to be completed in grades nine through twelve for high school graduation.

Junior high or middle school students who take high school courses have the option of taking classes for high school credit. If they choose to take classes for high school credit, it then becomes part of their permanent record. Students taking high school courses for credit, have the first 30 days of the semester to add/drop courses. Note: NCAA high school and college members reserve the right to approve transcripts for core academic grades. Their requirements may include A-F grading for core classes.
