Board Meeting Procedures

Quorum

A quorum will consist of the majority of the Board members.

A majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. A lesser number may meet and adjourn from time to time and compel the presence of absent members. The affirmative vote of the majority of the Board is required to transact business.

Vote Needed for Exercise of Powers

The affirmative vote of a majority of Board members will be necessary for exercising any of the Board's powers.

Board Member Voting

Each member's vote on all motions will be recorded in the minutes.

Abstaining from Vote

If a Board member chooses to abstain from voting, such abstention will be recorded.

Parliamentary Procedures

Except as otherwise provided by state law and/or Board policy, the rules of parliamentary procedure comprised in *Roberts Rules of Order (Revised 10th Edition)*, "Procedure in Small Boards" as modified by the Board shall govern the Board in its deliberations. Rules may be amended at any meeting by majority vote. The order of business may be suspended at any meeting by a majority vote of those present.

Reopening an Issue

An issue that has been officially acted upon may be placed on the agenda for reconsideration by any Board member wishing to submit new information which could result in a different decision.

After review of the information, a motion to reconsider may be made only by a member of the prevailing side. An affirmative vote of at least four Board members will place the original motion on the table for reconsideration.
