## Vending Machines

Vending machines dispensing nutritious foods/snacks or beverages are permitted utilizing the following standards:

### **Elementary Schools**

No food/snack or beverage vending machines will be placed in elementary schools for student use.

### **Middle School**

No food/snack vending machine will be placed at the middle school.

The sale of unsweetened water, 100 percent fruit juice, and fruit juice/water blend containing 50 percent or greater juice or 35 percent nectar with no added sweeteners, caffeine or herbs will be allowed in a vending machine available for after school purchase only. Beverages sold may not exceed 275 calories per unit.

### **High School**

The sale of unsweetened water, 100 percent fruit juice, and fruit juice/water blend containing 50 percent or greater juice or 35 percent nectar with no added sweeteners, caffeine or herbs and only one offering of a noncaffeine diet soft drink will be allowed in beverage vending machines. Beverages sold may not exceed 275 calories per unit.

No beverage machine located in the commons offering a soft drink may be operational during the time that breakfast and lunch is served.

Only “healthy” food/snacks may be sold in candy / snack food vending machines (Board policy EFA-AR - Local Wellness Program).

All beverage contracts need the approval of the superintendent.

One beverage vending machine per school is authorized in the teachers’ lounge.

Operation and financial management of these machines will be the responsibility of the principal. Machine proceeds will accrue to student activity funds.
