Relations with Home-Schooled Students**

The district recognizes the rights of parents to educate students at home and acknowledges the Education Service District's role in registering and monitoring test results for students who are being taught at home.

The district does not provide textbooks, materials, lesson plans or curriculum guides to students whose total instructional program is home schooled.

The district does not grant high school credit for home schooling or diplomas to home school students residing within the district. Parents who elect home schooling options are encouraged to pursue GED or community college diploma alternatives.

Part-time Enrollment

1. Further, the Board recognizes the potential for some students to benefit from the formal school program as well as from home instruction. Opportunity for partial enrollment will be extended to any resident student who wishes to attend the district.
2. Parents are responsible for transportation of students attending selected school offerings.
3. Students who choose partial enrollment may be eligible for cocurricular/extracurricular activities within the guidelines established by the district and the Oregon School Activities Association.
4. Only courses recognized by the state of Oregon will earn credits toward a diploma. The Board reaffirms its prerogative not to accept home instruction course credit toward graduation requirements.
