

Student Suspensions

1. Prior Notice - The student must be informed of school rules, regulations and practices.
2. Notice of Charges - The student must be informed of charges.
3. Opportunity to Present View - The student must be given the opportunity to be heard and present his/her view of the occurrence.
4. Student Notification of Actions to be Taken - The student must be given the reason(s) for the action, the duration of the suspension, and tentative procedures for reinstatement.
5. Parent Notification - The parents must be notified of the suspension, reasons for the action, the duration of the suspension, and the procedure for re-entry.
6. Serious or Persistent Cases - Building principals shall be responsible for informing the Superintendent of the details of serious or persistent cases of student misconduct.
