Public Conduct on District Property

It is the policy of the Board to maintain the school grounds and district properties in a manner that best serves and protects the public's interest.

No person on district property or grounds, including parking lots, will:

1. Injure or threaten to injure another;
2. Damage the property of another or of the district. Every effort will be made to reduce vandalism. Parents are held responsible for the damage done by their children and are required to reimburse the district for the cost of replacement and repair so provided by law;
3. Initiate or circulate a report, one knows to be false, concerning an alleged hazardous substance, impending fire, explosion, catastrophe or other emergency that will take place in or upon a school;
4. Violate traffic control. City police officers shall have the right and are encouraged to patrol school parking lots to control traffic on district property and to give general supervision of a like nature to any and all district properties and/or persons thereon.
 - a. Gasoline-driven "two wheelers," motorcycles, snowmobiles, all-terrain-vehicles and similar vehicles are prohibited from driving on and around school parking lots, driveways and related areas except to park such vehicle. This specifically includes the large field east of the district office.
 - b. Livestock is prohibited from being on school grounds except as authorized by superintendent.
5. Operate an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) or drone unless granted permission from the superintendent or designee, or as prohibited by Board policy ECACB - Unmanned Aircraft System (UAS) a.k.a. Drone;
6. Impede, delay, or otherwise interfere with the orderly conduct of the district's educational program or any other activity taking place on district property, which has been authorized by the board, superintendent, principal or other authorized administrator;
7. Enter any portion of district premises at any time for purposes other than those which are lawful and authorized by district officials;
8. Bring, possess, conceal, or use a weapon as prohibited by Board policy JFCJ - Weapons in the Schools, and state and federal law;

9. Possess, consume, sell, give, or deliver unlawful drugs and/or alcoholic beverages. Possess, sell, give or deliver drug paraphernalia;
10. Use, distribute or sell tobacco products or inhalant delivery systems;
11. Wear, possess, use, distribute, display or sell any clothing, jewelry, emblem, badge, symbols, sign or other items that is evidence of membership or affiliation with any gang. Use speech or commit any act or omission in furtherance of the interests of any gang or gang activity. A “gang” is defined as a group that identifies itself through the use of a name, unique appearance or language, including hand signs, claiming of geographical territory or the espousing of a distinctive belief system that frequently results in criminal activity;
12. Willfully violate board policies, administrative regulations or school rules, designed to maintain public order on district property.

Persons having no legitimate purpose or business on district property, or those violating or threatening to violate the above rules, may be issued a trespass citation, ejected from the premises and/or referred to law enforcement officials.
