Immunizations and Health Examinations

In order to safeguard the school community from the spread of certain communicable diseases and in recognition that prevention is a means of combating the spread of disease, the Board requires all students in its programs to be immunized against certain diseases in accordance with state statute, unless specifically exempt for religious or medical reasons.

All students enrolling in Lane ESD programs must present written evidence of meeting minimum requirements for immunization as required by Oregon law.

The Board shall exempt from its requirements for immunization each student whose parents/guardians object to the requirements on the grounds that such immunization is contrary to his/her religious beliefs. The parent's/guardian's objection shall be made in a written statement which will be kept on file with Lane ESD as long as the child is enrolled in the ESD program. The Board shall further exempt from the requirements each student who has a medical exemption signed by a physician. A tuberculosis status, however, shall not be exempted for religious or medical reasons.

The county health department will exclude from school any student who fails to comply with these requirements for immunization.
