Communicable Disease

Lane ESD shall provide reasonable protection for students against the risk of exposure to communicable disease. The ESD will follow the Oregon Department of Education and the state and local health authorities' rules and regulations pertaining to communicable diseases.

Protection from communicable disease generally shall be through immunization, exclusion or other measures provided for in Oregon Revised Statutes and rules of the County Health Department. Services generally will not be provided to students excluded under this policy unless otherwise required by law.

Where the ESD knows that a student is infected by any communicable disease for which the student would not be excluded under this policy, the school or ESD program involved shall take whatever reasonable steps it considers necessary to organize and operate its programs in a way which both furthers the education and protects the health of the students.

Lane ESD may, for the protection of both the infected student and the exposed student, provide an educational program in an alternative setting. A student shall continue in the alternative setting, if provided, until such time that:

1. The ESD determines that the student presents no unreasonable risk of infection to the other students and bears no unreasonable risk of opportunistic infections; or
2. The student is ordered to be returned to the classroom by a court or other authority of competent jurisdiction.

Lane ESD shall protect the confidentiality of each student's health condition/record to the extent possible consistent with the overall intent of this policy.
