

Security of Building and Grounds

The Board will establish systems and procedures that will promote a reasonable level of security for all district facilities, equipment and materials. A “reasonable level of security” is defined as the level which discourages dishonesty while not requiring substantially more resources to enforce than would be lost through acts of vandalism or theft. The systems shall deal with such areas as key control, intrusion alarms, fencing, lighting, inventory controls and all other means necessary to the implementation of this policy.

The superintendent or designee shall establish rules and regulations to implement this policy.

The Board encourages cooperation with local law enforcement and fire authorities and insurance company personnel in planning and carrying out proper security measures to preserve and protect the district’s investment in its physical plant.
